

Boarding Fees 2026/27



Years 7 to 8

- Per annum: £ 19,200.00
- Per term: £ 6,400.00
- Monthly: £ 1,600.00 (over 12 months July 26 to June 27)

Years 9 to 11

- Per annum: £ 19,476.00
- Per term: £ 6,492.00
- Monthly: £ 1,623.00 (over 12 months July 26 to June 27)

Sixth Form – Years 12 & 13

- Per annum: £ 20,376.00
- Per term: £ 6,792.00
- Monthly: £ 1,698.00 (over 12 months July 26 to June 27)

Payment of boarding fees

This is by direct debit and there are 2 options:

- Monthly direct debits paid over 12 months from July preceding that start of the academic year through to June of the following year.
- Termly direct debits paid in just before the start of each term.

Notice period

A term's notice needs to be provided in writing to the Head, or fees in lieu of notice will be charged. A term's notice means notice given no later than the first day of the term preceding the term to which the notice relates.

Registration fees *(for students registering to start in 2026/27)*

Registration fees of £95 are payable for all new applications. This fee is non-refundable and is to cover the administration cost of processing your application.

Deposits (for students registering to start in 2027/28)

- £3,250 where both parents/guardians are resident in the UK and where the pupil is resident in the UK and holds a British passport
- £6,500 for those pupils whose normal residence is outside the United Kingdom, or those who require a Child Student Visa
- All deposits are refundable at the end of the pupil's time with the School unless a pupil is withdrawn. The deposit cannot be offset against boarding fees
- If you would like to donate all or part of your deposit to the College, at the end of your child's time at the school, we would be very happy to accept this as a donation to our bursary or general funds. These funds are managed by a separate charitable entity, the Holyport College Foundation, for the exclusive benefit of the College and its students.
- For students joining the College in the 2026/27 academic year, the deposits are as previously stated for entrants in this year, namely £3,250 for UK and British Passport Holders, and £6,500 for those pupils whose normal residence is outside the United Kingdom, or those who require a Child Student Visa

Extra-curricular activities

Extra-curricular activities run by College teachers from 2.15 to 3.15pm on a Monday and 4pm to 5pm Tuesday to Thursday are included.

Extra-curricular activities which incur an additional fee include music and drama tuition and some sports coaching including tennis, dance and basketball. This will be communicated in advance of each term and will be invoiced by and paid directly to these teachers/coaches and not through the College.

iPads

iPads are an essential part of the teaching approach at Holyport College for students in years 7 to 11. Parents/carers of students are required to purchase an iPad through the College, the cost of which for the academic year 2026/27 is £299 for the iPad, case, stylus, management software and installation / set-up.

This ensures that all students have the same IT equipment and educational and safeguarding software throughout their journey to GCSEs.

Payment for the iPad bundle is collected via ParentPay. Parents/carers can choose to make this payment all up front or split over 3 months: 5 June 2026, 6 July 2026, and 5 August 2026.

Future years

Fees are reviewed annually and may be subject to change at the discretion of the Governing Board. The impact of inflation on the cost of the College's educational provision is a key factor considered in this annual review.
