Recommended Materials:

Please be advised that A-Level art does involve some additional equipment and costs.

We would recommend that all students purchase:

- A toolbox to store brushes/paint/tools (similar to the below able to be padlocked).
- A set of Acrylic paint (preferably Daler Rowney or Windsor and Newton Brand)
- Padlock
- Pack of fine liner pens
- White gel pens.
- Watercolour set (Optional- best buy on Cass Art)
- Series of fine brushes for watercolour/ acrylic detail
- Oil Brushes (Hog hair or synthetic, various sizes)
- Fan brush as below
- Pack of household decorating brushes
- Water based oil paints, No white spirit/ turps.

Whilst art does provide many materials for in school use or to purchase in department, students at A-Level really should be building their own sets.
