

# Uniform

The College expects high standards of uniform and appearance at all times. This includes all occasions where the uniform is worn outside College grounds and when travelling to and from the College, school trips, fixtures and activities. All items of uniform and other clothing should be named, clean, tidy and in good repair at all times. Our Sixth Form has a separate dress code which can be found [here](#).

## Rules on uniform and appearance - Years 7-11

- **College Blazers and Jackets:** College blazers or jackets must be worn when travelling to and from College, and during the school day, unless exception is given by the school. Blazers and jackets may only be taken off during lessons with permission from the teacher.
- **Shirts and Blouses:** Must be plain white and long enough to cover the top of the trousers / kilt to allow it to be tucked in.
- **Kilts:** Kilts must be our charcoal and Eton Blue kilts, purchased through the College's supplier, Goyals. The length of the kilt must be not altered to be any more than three inches above the knee when standing up.
- **College Pullover:** If a pullover is worn, it must be the College long sleeved or sleeveless grey sweater with Eton Blue trim, purchased through Goyals.
- **Socks and Tights:** Must be plain dark grey or black.
- **Shoes:** Shoes are to be black leather, plain, flat, formal and polished.
- **Outdoor Coats & Jackets:** If an outdoor coat is worn it must be plain. Outdoor clothes are not to be worn during lessons.
- **Hats, Scarves, Gloves:** All other items (including hats, scarves, gloves) must be plain and unobtrusive. Extreme styles will not be permitted.
- **Bags:** Pupils must use a school bag which can carry school books without damaging them. Bags must be plain black. A separate plain navy or black bag must be used for all PE and Games kit. A Holyport College kit bag is available and can be purchased through Goyals.
- **Hair:** Hair must be clean, tidy and in keeping with the formality of the College. Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back when required for reasons of health and safety.
- **Jewellery:** Jewellery and piercings must be understated and not excessive. Hooped/pendant earrings/piercings are not permitted for reasons of health and safety.
- **Make-up:** Any make-up worn must be subtle and unobtrusive. False eye lashes and false nails are not permitted.

*The Head may grant exceptions but only where this is required as a matter of sincere religious observance. Pupils who come to school in clothing that the Head or Deputy Head consider to be unacceptable may be sent home.*
